CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF SCHOOL/HOUSE APPOINTMENTS

SECONDARY SECTION: -

The following are norms for the selection of School/ House appointments for the session 2024-25.

1) The different categories of competitions considered for the nominations are:-

- a) Academics
- b) Inter House CCA
- c) Inter House Sports
- d) Outside CCA
- e) Outside Sports
- f) Awards (Principal Honors, Full Attendance, Subject Proficiency)
- g) Appointments

2) Percentage fixed for various categories of competitions for the nomination of Head Boy/Head Girl/School and House Appointees:-

- a) Academics – 50%
- b) Inter House CCA – 10%
- c) Inter House Sports – 10%
- d) Outside CCA – 10%
- e) Outside Sports – 10%
- f) Awards (Principal Honors, Full Attendance, Subject Proficiency) 5%
- g) Appointments – 5%

3) Percentage fixed for various categories of competitions for the nomination of Sports Captain Boy/Sports Captain Girl:-

- a) Academics – 30%
- b) Inter House CCA – 10%
- c) Inter House Sports – 20%
- d) Outside CCA – 05%
- e) Outside Sports – 25%
- f) Awards (Principal Honors, Full Attendance, Subject Proficiency)-5%
- g) Appointments – 5%

4. In every class the Section topper will be nominated as the class Leader for that section.

5. The same student cannot become a class leader for two consecutive years but there is an exemption for class X student. A student, who is a class leader in class IX can become class leader in class X also if he/she is the topper of the class/section IX.

6. Points awarded for Each Level of Competitions:-

7. Each contestant may submit 32 certificates per class(the best 8 certificates from each category) for any School/House appointment. For Ex. A Students who is contesting as Head Boy or Head Girl will submit 32 certificates for class VIII and 32 certificates for Class IX.
8. CCA/Sports competitions which are announced in the school only will be considered for thenomination. It is mandatory for the child get nominated from the school for any competition to be considered for the House/School Appointments.
9. If any student participates in any competition other than what is announced in the school, the certificates will not be considered for selection of appointees. However, the performance of such students in competitions that are not announced in the school will be duly recognized and appreciated.
10. Students have to submit the certificates in the order given in the proforma for selection of appointees.
11. If a student participates in different competitions conducted by the same organization and wins prizes or certificates, such certificates will be considered separately.
12. A student who has studied in VPSPS from Class VI to Class IX is only eligible to contest for School Head Boy/Head Girl.
13. A student who had studied in VPSPS till Primary and left the school for a year ortwo and returned to VPSPS is not eligible to contest for Head Boy/ Head Girl.
14. A student who studies in VPSPS for two consecutive years (VIII and IX) is eligible to contest for Sports Captain and other appointments except Head Bov/Head Girl.
15. A student can become an ethics leader consecutively for any number of years.
16. A student who has taken a Re-Test in any examination on the basis of medical grounds or any emergency situation with prior permission will be considered to contest for an appointment.
17. Final calculations of each appointee will be uploaded on the School website www.vpspsvja.ac.in for thePublic Scrutiny.
18. Two days of time will be given to the parents to raise any issues/objections if they are not satisfied or has any doubt regarding the calculations.
19. Any parent whose child is a contestant for a particular category of appointment will be allowed to see the certificates of other contestants of the same category, if they are not satisfied with the result.
20. Decision of School Management Committee is final for all the School/House Appointments.
21. The list of competitions which are considered for the school appointments is annexed (Annexure I)with this document. No competitions will be added or deleted during the academic session.
22. The rules framed and indicated from point 1 to 21 are final and will not be changed during the academic year. Any deletions or modifications will be allowed only for the next session 2025-26.
